Summary of Key Matters Discussed

1. What was the plan for improving the Group's performance?

The management informed that the main operation of the Group was Bedding in Malaysia. Bedding industry had not been doing well in Malaysia. Dreamland recently set up own retail outlets selling own products directly to consumers. This strategy provided better control on costing and overall business management. Dreamland also actively participated in event sales.

2. A shareholder stated that since the Company had no definite plan for the substantial cash in the Company, the Company should look into cash distribution to shareholders and undertake shares buy back as the shares were priced less than the cash in the Company. He further asked if the Company had looked into business acquisitions.

The Company informed that it had been careful and prudent in its cash management. The Company had appointed bankers to help look for new business opportunities too and indeed had evaluated quite a number of business proposals, but not materialized. The Company would continue to look for new business opportunities.

On shares buy back and cash distribution, the Company informed that the cash was meant for business expansion and acquisition. If the Company proceeded to execute shares buy back, that would not help in compliance with Bursa's public shareholding spread requirement.
